In an effort to keep you informed of important opportunities affecting your child's learning, this letter is written to explain supplemental educational services (SES).

Your child may be eligible to receive free tutoring through SES. If your child qualifies for free or reduced price lunch, then your child is eligible for services this school year. This extra help may be provided to your child in reading, math, and/or language arts. The support services can be provided before or after school, on weekends, during school vacation times, or during summer. This is at no cost to you.
